Data for the maps presented in this publication has been collected via on-line survey as part of the assessment of organizational capacities of women's organizations. The assessment was conducted by Pact and its partners – the All-Ukrainian NGO “Democracy Development Center” and the International Charitable Foundation “Ukrainian Foundation for Public Health” within the framework of the project “Women of Ukraine: heard, capable, resilient” undertaken with the financial support of the Government of Canada provided through Global Affairs Canada .

On-line survey was conducted in July-August 2019. On-line questionnaire was circulated via specialized gender mailing lists and social media. 248 organizations shared information about themselves by filling the questionnaire. Information was verified in accordance with the impact areas identified by the organizations (1) women's rights protection, (2) services for women and girls, (3) advancing gender equality. Verified database includes information on 212 organizations which was used to develop the maps.

This publication includes seven maps. One map shows the age of the organizations. The rest six maps show the area of activities. The maps do not show precise geographic location of the women's organizations but show their presence.

Limitations of the maps:

The data source for different characteristics of women's organizations visualized on the maps is on-line survey which was filled only by those organizations that received a questionnaire and were willing to respond. The maps presented in the publication should be considered as illustrative and those that demonstrate how information about women's organizations can be visualized, analyzed and used for decision making. Pact will make its best effort to encourage other women's organizations share information about their activities to visualize it on the next reiteration of the maps.

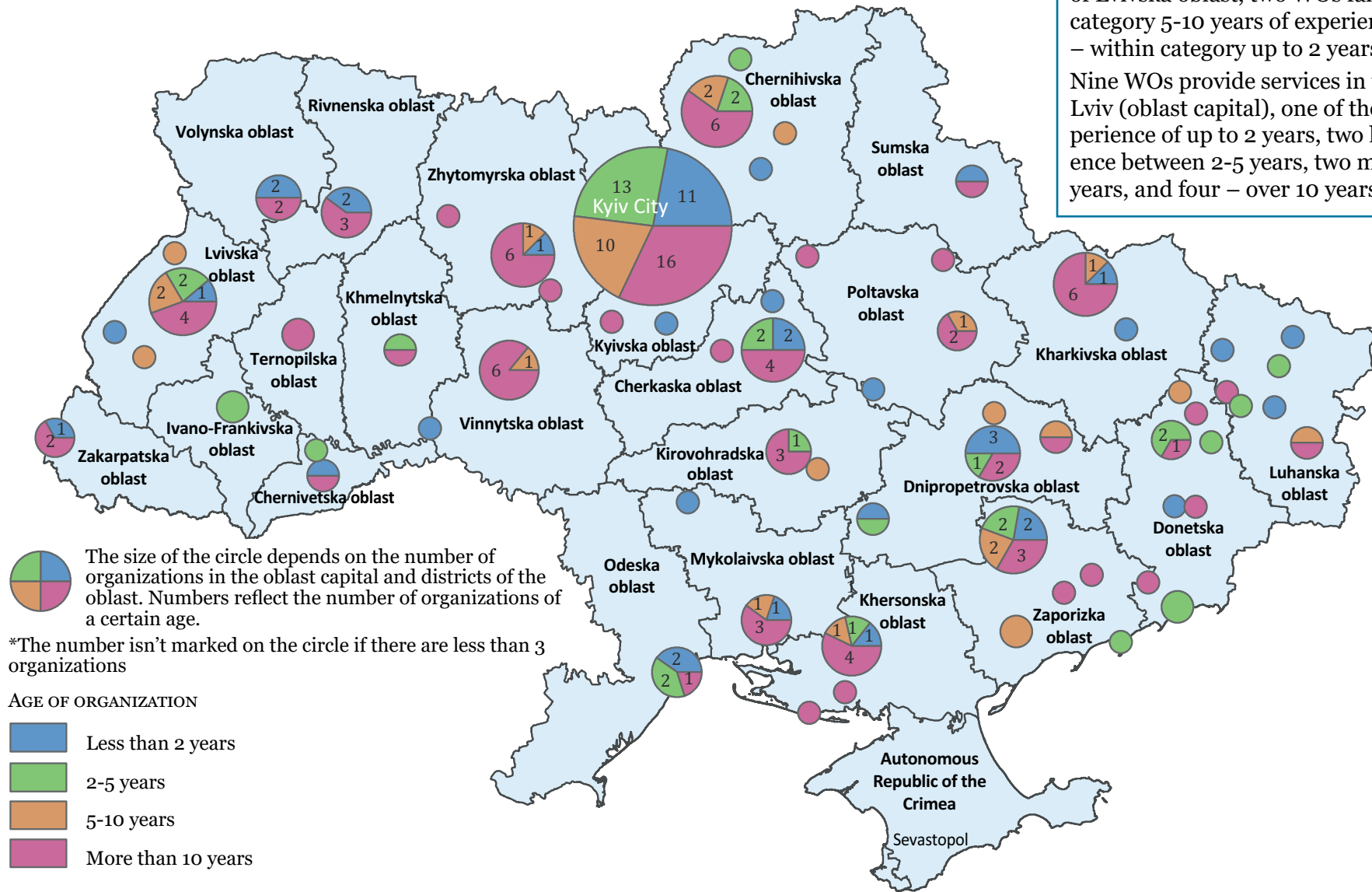


Women's organizations (WOs) by age

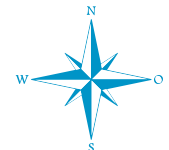
How to interpret data
 (Using Lvivska oblast as an example)

12 women's organizations from Lvivska oblast participated in the on-line survey. Three WO's provide services in the raions of Lvivska oblast, two WO's fall within category 5-10 years of experience and one – within category up to 2 years.

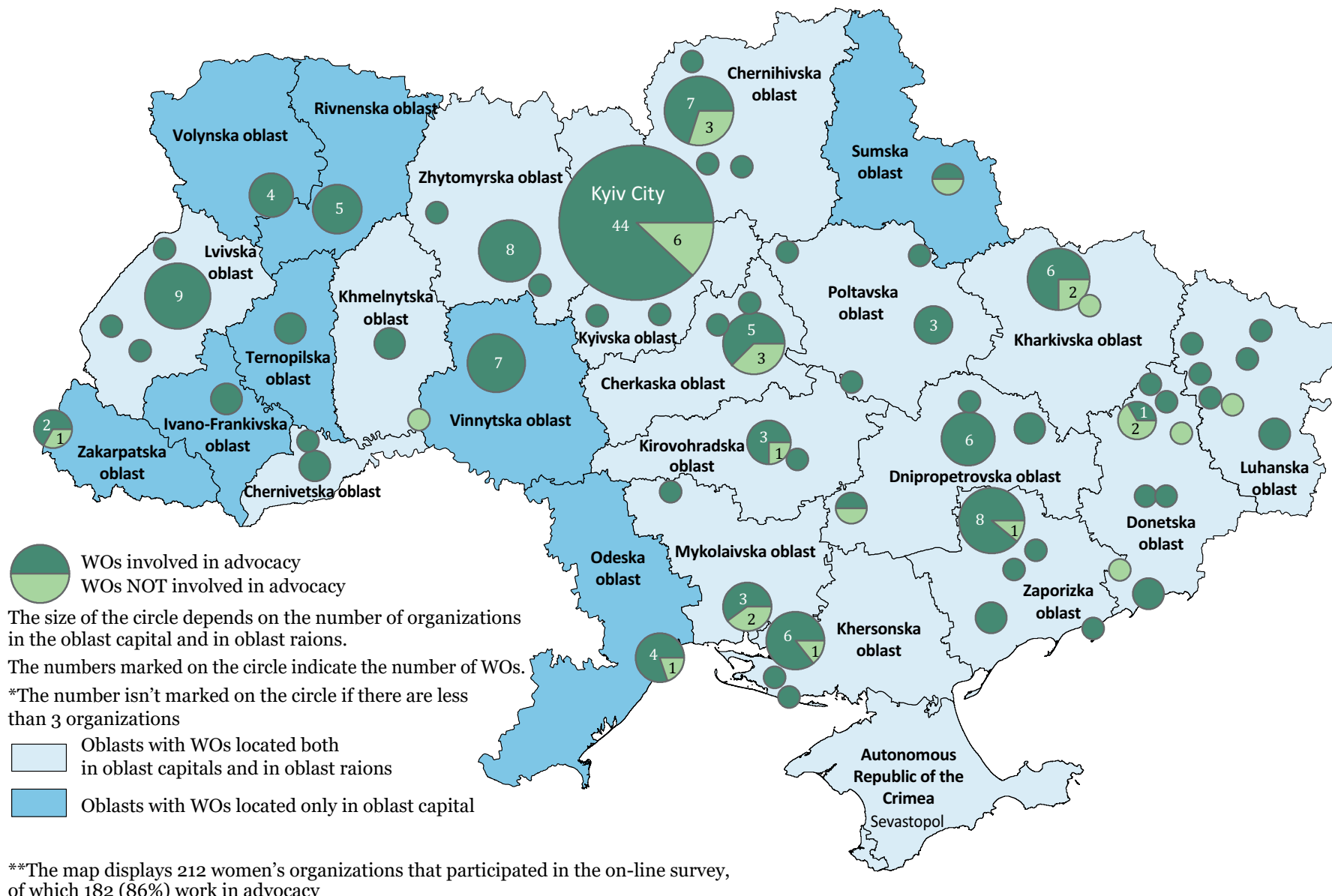
Nine WO's provide services in the city of Lviv (oblast capital), one of them has experience of up to 2 years, two have experience between 2-5 years, two more – 5-10 years, and four – over 10 years.



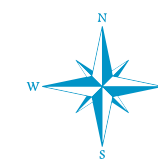

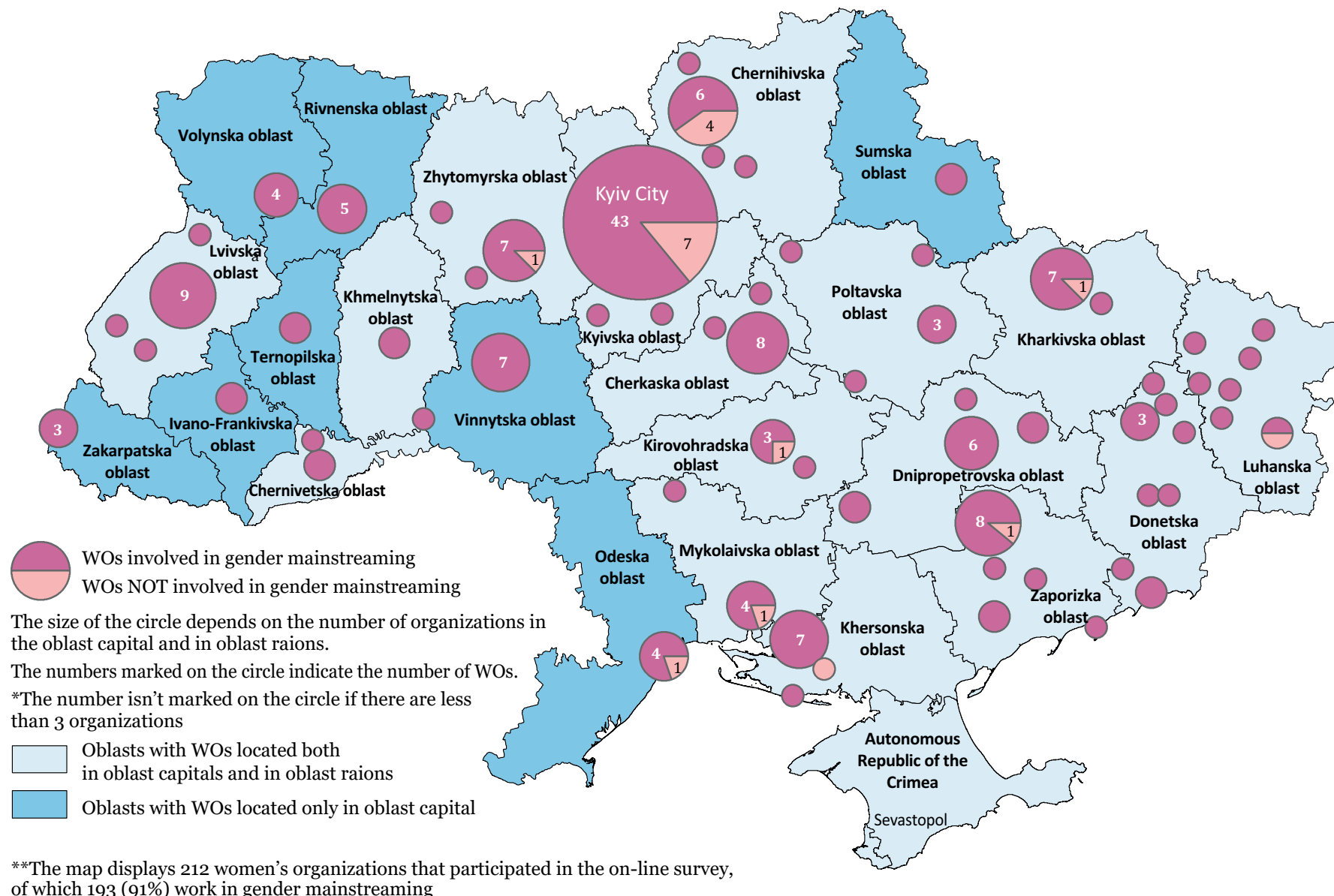
Women's organizations (WOs) focusing on advocacy



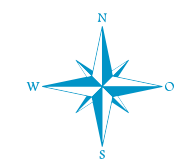
**The map displays 212 women's organizations that participated in the on-line survey, of which 182 (86%) work in advocacy



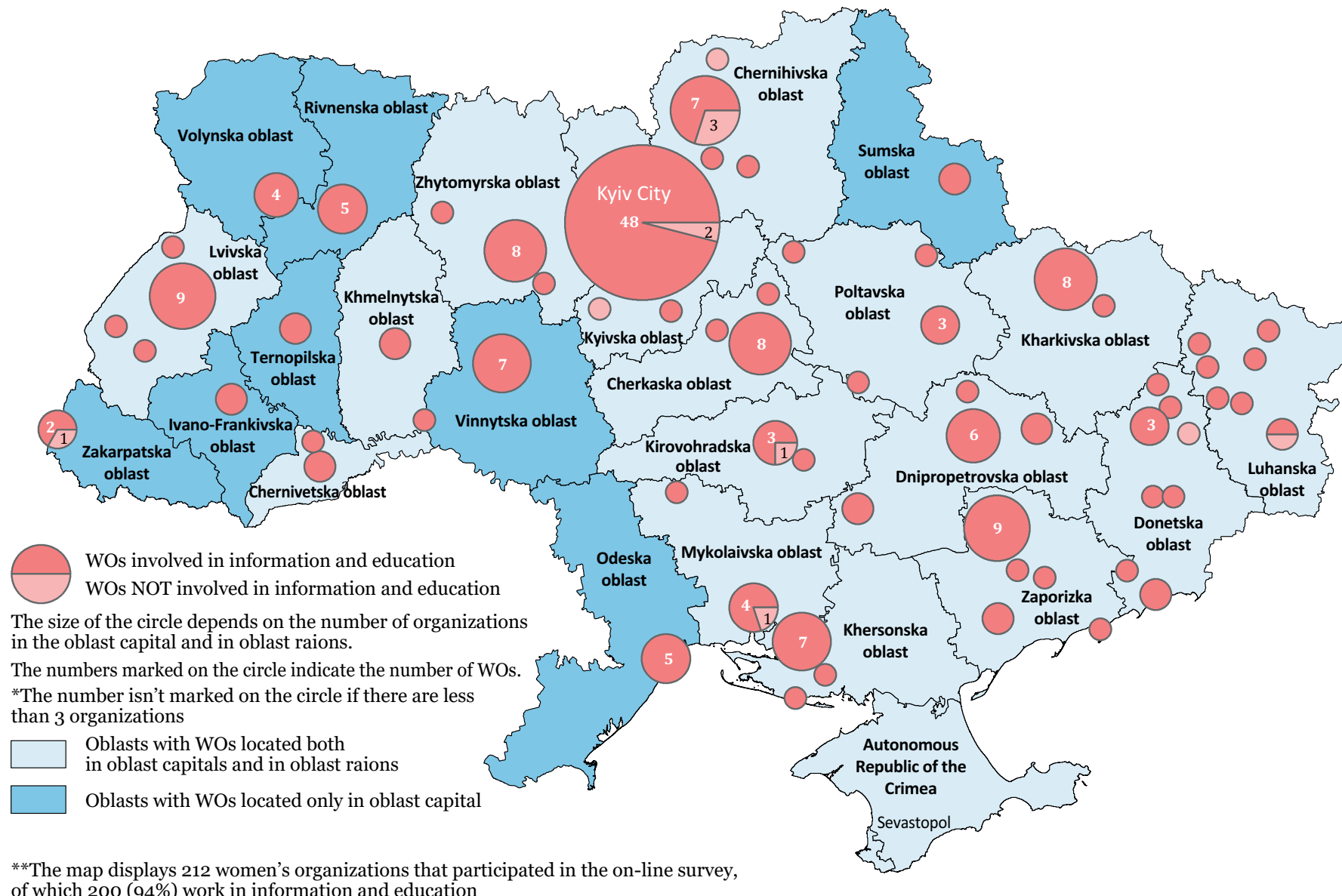
Women's organizations (WOs) focusing on gender mainstreaming



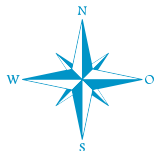
**The map displays 212 women's organizations that participated in the on-line survey, of which 193 (91%) work in gender mainstreaming



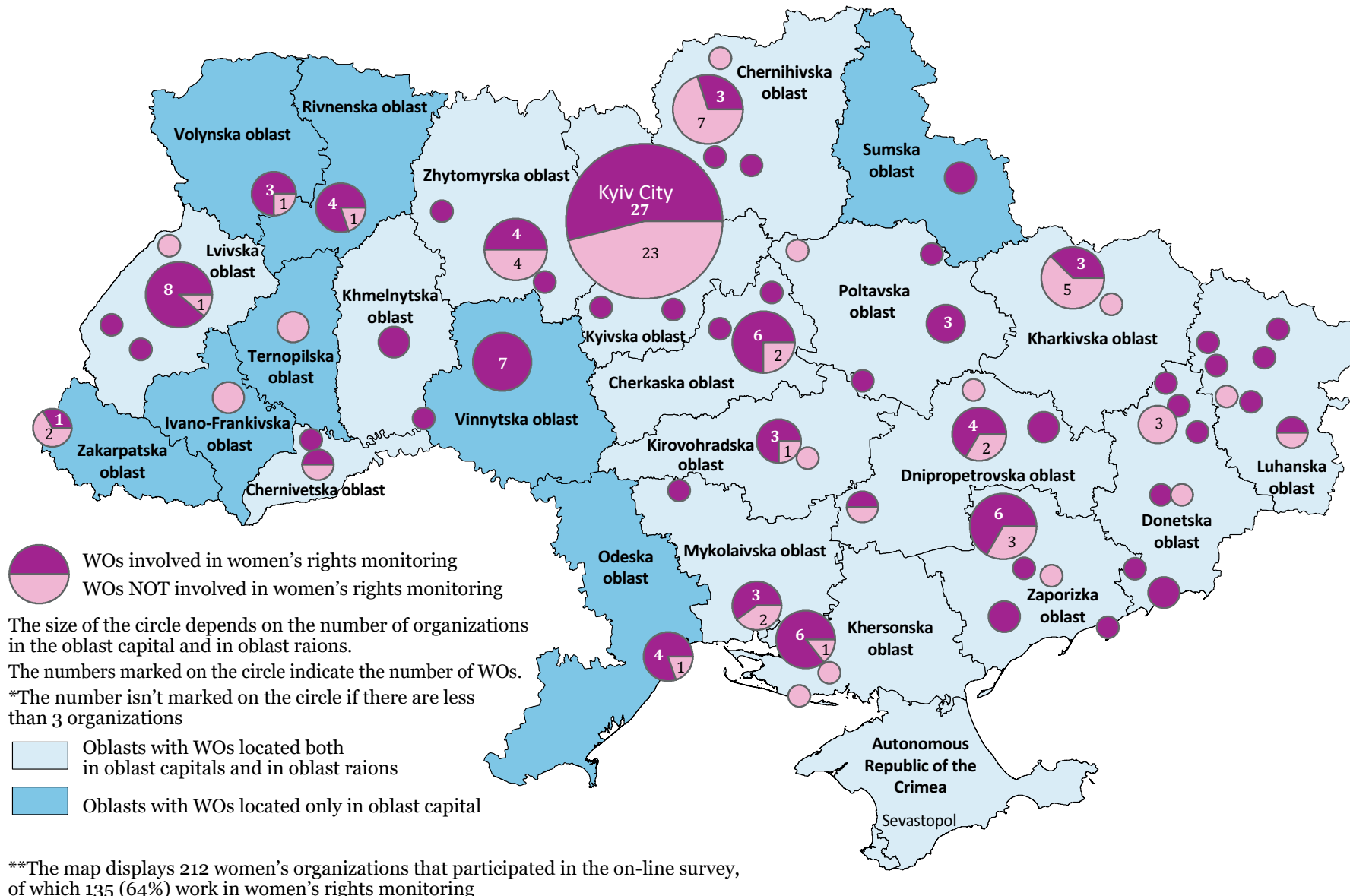
Women's organizations (WOs) focusing on information and education



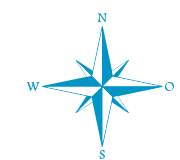
**The map displays 212 women's organizations that participated in the on-line survey, of which 200 (94%) work in information and education



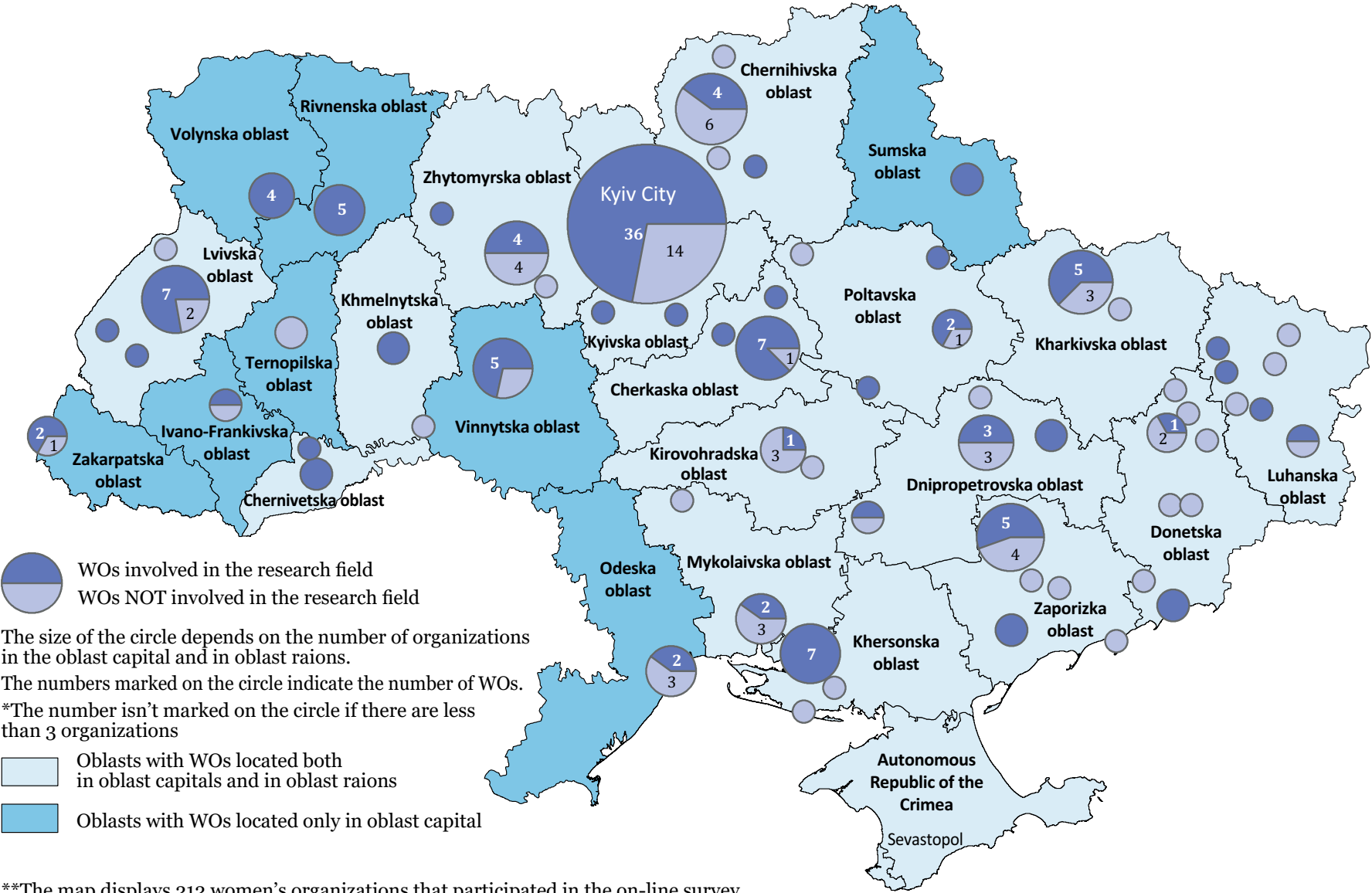
Women's organizations (WOs) focusing on women's rights monitoring



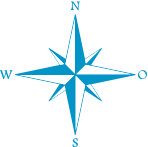
**The map displays 212 women's organizations that participated in the on-line survey, of which 135 (64%) work in women's rights monitoring



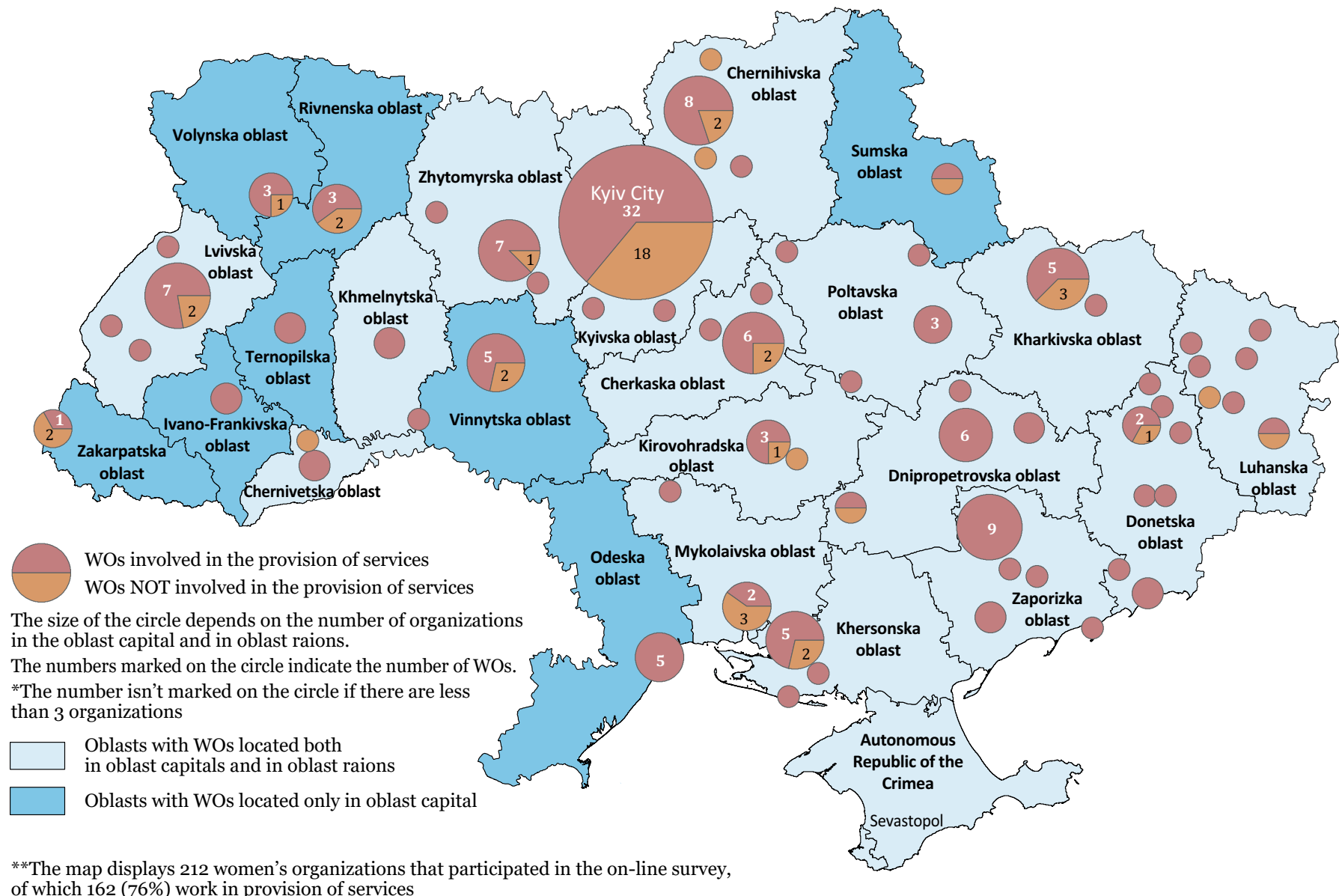
Women's organizations (WOs) working in the research field



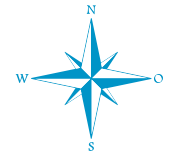
**The map displays 212 women's organizations that participated in the on-line survey, of which 131 (62%) work in the research field
